

RESOLUTION 2009-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (hereinafter "AMATS"), is making available funding from the Federal Stimulus Funds to make capital improvements to the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram anticipates being a successful applicant for the grant funds that will be made available from the AMATS for capital improvements to the Village of Hiram.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, OHIO, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION ONE: The Village Administrator of Hiram is hereby authorized to apply for the available grants from the AMATS to be used for capital improvements. The Village of Hiram Village Administrator has applied for \$185,000.00 to install storms, curbs and gutters, all of which will be installed on the portion of State Route 305 which is in the Village limits.

SECTION TWO: As awarded, the Village matching investment in this project will be \$37,000.00. The total amount of grant funds awarded is \$148,000.00.


SECTION THREE: That the Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept \$148,000.00 of funds from the AMATS for capital improvements.

SECTION FOUR: All actions taken by the administration prior to the passage of this Resolution to advance the Village of Hiram's application for AMATS grants are hereby ratified.


SECTION FIVE: This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage, the particular emergency being the need to apply for the grant funds prior to the deadline set forth in the grant application.

SECTION SIX: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 2009, as an emergency.


