

ORDINANCE 2024-08

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 2915 FOR THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Police Chief has entered into an agreement with Hiram Township for patrol services for 2024 and has agreed to pay up front annually for the patrol services; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Police Chief has requested that a Special Revenue Fund be created to receive this annual payment so that both Hiram Township and the Police Department can monitor and track the costs associated with the patrol services agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram desires to comply with the Ohio Revised Code 5705.12 which impliedly requires all requests for new fund numbers have legislation passed by Council attached to the request.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio two thirds or more of its members concurring:


SECTION 1: That the Fiscal Officer is authorized to request fund approval to the Auditor of State to establish a Special Revenue Fund. Said fund shall be established to receive the monies derived from the agreement with Hiram Township for sustained patrol services with the Hiram Police Department.

SECTION 2: That the Fiscal Officer is instructed to send a letter requesting an increase in the resources available to the Village by the amount collected on behalf of Hiram Township to the County Auditor.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure effective immediately upon its passage to enable the Village to cover the costs of patrol services under the agreement with Hiram Township in a timely manner and for the further reason that this practice will preserve the financial well being of the Village and comply with the Ohio Revised Code, and will protect the public safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Hiram and Hiram Township.

SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
