

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-16

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE FIVE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM RECOGNIZING THE HIRAM HISTORICAL SOCIETY

WHEREAS, The Village Council has determined that the Hiram Historical Society provides an important service to the Village of Hiram as the custodian of Village of Hiram historical memorabilia and official group responsible for collecting, documenting and preserving the Village of Hiram historical memorabilia, as it may deem interesting or desirable.

WHEREAS, the Hiram Village Council has considered enactment of Chapter 146 of the Village Codified Ordinances to formally recognize the Hiram Historical Society as the custodian of historical memorabilia for the Village of Hiram and has recommended changes to the code as the result of the consideration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio a majority or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Village of Hiram Codified Ordinances are amended by the enactment of Chapter 146 as is set forth in the attached Exhibit "A," specifically the additions shown in the bold, italicized text.

SECTION 2: In all other respects, Title Five of the Village of Hiram Ordinances as previously enacted is hereby ratified.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.

Second Reading: July 9, 2024

CHAPTER 146

Hiram Historical Society.

146.01 HIRAM HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

The group now in existence and known as the Hiram Historical Society is designated and recognized as the official historical society for the Village so long as it continues to be an active organization and conducts public meetings in the Village at least once each year for the election of trustees, at which meeting each Hiram Historical Society member who is present shall have one vote. The Hiram Historical Society shall include one trustee who is a representative (either an elected official or employee) of the Village of Hiram. The Hiram Historical Society shall be the custodian of Village of Hiram historical memorabilia and official group responsible for collecting, documenting and preserving the Village of Hiram historical memorabilia, as it may deem interesting or desirable.
