

ORDINANCE 2024-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief for the Village of Hiram continues to submit a request for reimbursement from the Ohio Attorney General's office for State mandated Continued Professional Training for 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief was a successful grant recipient through the State of Ohio, Office of Budget and Management's Ohio Ambulance Impacted Industry Program and has requested the Fiscal Officer to amend appropriations in Fund 2153 to allow the Fire Department to begin utilizing the grant funds for Employee Retention; and

WHEREAS, the Hiram Recreation and Parks Board of the Village of Hiram was a successful grant recipient from the Hiram Community Trust Grant to cultivate community through hosting art and music events in Hiram Parks over the summer; and

WHEREAS, to meet these obligations several funds will need to have their appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated funds:


