

ORDINANCE 2012-5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) GENERAL GOVERNMENT (700) INCOME TAX DEPARTMENT (755) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it was determined by Council to hire a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) to assist with the Social Security issue resulting from the Ohio Public Employee Retirement System (OPERS) determination; and

WHEREAS, the amounts needed to pay the CPA for his services must be appropriated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Government Section of the General Fund Other Operations section is \$192,494. The estimated cost of the services to be provided by the CPA is \$6,000. After amendment of the appropriations the new total for the Other Operations section of the General Government will be \$ 198,494. The new amount in the General Fund will be \$844,300. The new amount in the Income Tax Department will be \$7,102.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to amend the appropriations of the Village in advance of payment for the CPA services to the Village, all to provide for the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
