

ORDINANCE 2012-06

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF EDWARD SAMEC AS THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE HIRAM POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND WAIVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT SET FORTH IN THE OHIO REVISED CODE

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that Edward Samec be appointed as the Police Chief of the Village of Hiram: and

WHEREAS, the Mayor appointed Edward Samec as the Chief of Police for the Village of Hiram, which appointment was with the advice and consent of the Village Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has requested that the Council waive the residency requirement for Chief Edward Samec.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, County of Portage, State of Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members thereto elected concurring that:

Section 1: The Council hereby concurs with and approves the final appointment of Edward Samec as the Chief of Police of the Village of Hiram.

Section 2: The Council hereby waives the residence requirement set forth by Ohio Revised Code 737.15 for Chief Edward Samec.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
