

ORDINANCE 2012-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE NEW SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2909) AMERICA'S FARMERS GROW COMMUNITIES GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department has received a grant in the amount of \$2,500 from the Monsanto Fund to be used to purchase fire equipment; and

WHEREAS, a new special revenue fund (2909) has been established to account for the deposit of these funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in this fund are ZERO and need to be increased to \$2,500. The funds being placed in this fund are grant funds.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor being the grant has already been applied for and the Village of Hiram Fire Department has been awarded the grant.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
