

ORDINANCE 2012-8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the former Police Chief was retained to assist the new Police Chief acclimating to the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor was voted a pay increase that was not appropriated and needs to be.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$844,300 through Ordinance 2012-5. The General Fund needs to be increased by \$10,304 making the new total \$854,604.


SECTION 2: The new total for the Police Department will be: Personal Services \$127, 654 and Other Operations \$127,946. The total appropriations for the Police Department will be \$255,600. This is an increase of \$1,760 for the two weeks of independent contractor pay to the former Police Chief.

SECTION 3: The new total for the General Government section of the General Fund will be: \$121,846 for Personal Services and Other Operations of \$196,670. The total appropriations for the General Government section will be \$318,516. This represents an increase of \$10,368 in the Personal Services and a decrease of \$1,824 in the Other Operations. The net effect is \$8,544 increase.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor so that payroll obligations can be met and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


