

ORDINANCE 2012-9

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND THE OPERS DETERMINATION FUND (9924) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village will owe Social Security for the employer portion on the amount of Fire Fighter employee wages determined to be ineligible for participation in the Ohio Public Employee Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the employer portion of the Social Security payment has not been appropriated in either the Social Security or the OPERS Determination fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund (1000) after Ordinance 2012-8 will be \$854,604. The amount anticipated at this time to be the employer portion of the Social Security obligation is \$37,098.28, as calculated by the Assistant Fiscal Officer. The increased appropriations in the General Fund will be \$891,702.28.

SECTION 2. The current appropriations in the OPERS Determination Fund (9924) are \$57,948.84. The amount of the increase needs to be the amount of the employer portion of Social Security, \$37,098.28. The increased appropriations in the OPERS Determination Fund (9924) will be \$95,047.12.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to meet the financial obligations of the Village and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




