

ORDINANCE 2012-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee was informed on February 28, 2012 at their regular meeting that Hiram College has agreed to pay one half of the amount of the cost of the Winrock Road plat; and

WHEREAS, the cost which remains the responsibility of the Village is estimated to be \$3,500.00; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no money appropriated for this expense.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in General Fund after Ordinance 2012-9 are \$891,702.28. This amount must be increased by \$3500 and will result in the General Fund appropriations totaling \$895,202.28.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to pay outstanding bills of the village and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




