

ORDINANCE 2012-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) IN THE COMMUNITY PLANNING AND ZONING DEPARTMENT (410) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a payment due for the Winrock plat and the Finance Committee determined it should be paid from the zoning area of the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations are amended in the General Fund in Ordinance 2012-10 to cover the \$3500 cost the Village is obligated to pay.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Community Planning and Zoning (410) area of the General Fund are \$9,215 with \$3,030 in Personal Services and \$6,185 in Other Operations. The new distribution will be \$3,121 in Personal Services and \$9,594 in Other Operations. The new total will be \$12,715, an increase of \$3500.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to pay outstanding bills for the village and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


This piece of legislation was passed as an emergency on March 13, 2012
