

ORDINANCE 2012-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SHOP WITH A COP FUND (2273) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in Resolution 2012-12 the application for and the acceptance of grant funds was authorized by Council; and

WHEREAS, those grant funds and donations will need to be appropriated so the Police Chief can make expenditures from this fund.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in this fund are ZERO. The budgeted receipts are \$3,000. The appropriations need to be increased to \$3,000.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor being the grant has already been applied for and the Village of Hiram Police Department has been awarded the grant.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


