

ORDINANCE 2012-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, an error was made in the calculation of the dispatching contract; and

WHEREAS, a percentage was used instead of a factor; and

WHEREAS, this created an additional amount of \$2,234 due on the contract this year and a discussion was held at the March 27, 2012 Finance Committee Meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Committee decided this is an unanticipated expenditure and the appropriations in the Police Department and the Fire Department need to be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in The General Fund after Ordinance 2012-11 are \$948,515.10. This amount needs to be increased by \$2,234 and will result in the new General Fund appropriations being \$950,749.10.


SECTION 2: The appropriations in the Police Department Other Operations Section would be increased by \$1,117. This would make the new total appropriations in the Police Department \$256,717.

SECTION 3: The appropriations in the Fire Department Other Operations Section would be increased by \$1,117. This would make the new total appropriations in the Fire Department \$136,626.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to pay outstanding bills of the village and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




