

ORDINANCE 2012-17

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A STORM WATER EASEMENT FROM CREEKSIDE APARTMENTS AT HIRAM, LLC AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, citizens in the vicinity of the Creekside Apartments at Hiram, LLC have suffered ongoing difficulties with storm water; and

WHEREAS, Creekside Apartments at Hiram, LLC has agreed to grant an easement for storm water management purposes to the Village of Hiram, to be used by the Village in an attempt to alleviate the flooding which has occurred in the area of the easement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: An easement, in substantial conformity with the easement attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor so as to advance the health, safety and general welfare of the municipality, and so that storm water management infrastructure can be established on the property within the easement this spring.
