

ORDINANCE 2012-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$153,090 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Land and Water Conservation Program Grant needs to be funded by an advance of \$70,000 and a transfer of \$67,178; and

WHEREAS, the Nature Works grant needs to be funded by an advance of \$15,912.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:


Section 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$950,749.10. With the addition of \$153,090 the new appropriations will be \$1,103,839.10.

Section 2: The breakdown of the increase will be as follows: transfers out will be increased by \$137,178. The advances out will be increased by \$85,912. In the General Fund line item 1000-910-910-0920 is to be used for the transfer to the Land and Water Conservation Fund (2910) in the amount of \$67,718. In the General Fund line item 1000-920-920-0920 will be used for the advance to the Land and Water Conservation Fund (2910) in the amount of \$70,000. In the General Fund the line item 1000-920-920-0921 will be used for the advance of \$15,912 to the Nature Works Grant Fund (2911).


Section 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Village Administrator to begin using the grant funds to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.





