

ORDINANCE 2012-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SHOP WITH A COP FUND (2273) BY \$3,000.

WHEREAS, Chief Samec has received a grant from the Hiram Community Trust in the amount of \$2,000 to use for the Shop with a Cop program; and

WHEREAS, Chief Samec wants all the funds for the Shop with a Cop program to go into the Shop with a Cop Fund; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations in this fund will need to be increased to accommodate this grant and any additional funding that may be received.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio a majority of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Shop with a Cop Fund (2273) are \$3,000.


SECTION 2: An additional \$3,000 has been requested making the new total appropriation in this fund \$6,000.


