

ORDINANCE 2012-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE WATERWORKS BOND RETIREMENT FUND (3901) BY .02 CENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the appropriations in the Waterworks Bond Retirement Fund need to be increased to allow for all the remaining monies to be transferred to the General Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Waterworks Bond Retirement Fund (3901) are \$243.73.

SECTION 2: An additional .02 cents will make the new total appropriation in this fund \$243.75. This is the entire amount of the remaining monies.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor so that the money will be ready to transfer as soon as Resolution 2012-25 is passed.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


