

ORDINANCE 2012-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) POLICE DEPARTMENT (110).

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has determined he will need more monies in the Personal Services section of his budget than is currently appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief decided to move money from the Other Operations section of his budget to the Personal Services section of his budget.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the Police Department are \$256,717 with \$127,654 in Personal Services and \$129,063 in Other Operations. The new distribution needs to be \$138,998 in Personal Services and \$117,719 in Other Operations. There is no change in the total appropriations.






