

ORDINANCE 2012-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND (2910) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 2012-19 the appropriations in the General Fund were amended to accommodate the transfer and advance to this grant fund; and

WHEREAS, those grant funds and the matching funds from the village need to be appropriated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The current appropriations in this fund are ZERO. The budgeted receipts are \$137,718. There will be \$70,000 advanced from the General Fund and \$67,178 transferred from the General Fund. The advance will need to be repaid to the General Fund (1000). The appropriations need to be increased to \$207,178.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because the appraising of the property needs to take place as soon as possible to comply with the terms of the grant.






