

ORDINANCE 2012-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE NEW FUND (9924) OPERS DETERMINATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) has determined a number of Hiram Village employees are not eligible to participate in the OPERS for at least a portion of the their employment with the Village and has refunded contributions to OPERS made by these employees; and

WHEREAS, a new fund is being created and appropriations need to be in place to process these refunds.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in this fund are ZERO and need to be increased to \$57,948.84. The funds being placed in this fund are to process monies refunded by the employee portion of OPERS contributions for employees determined by the OPERS to be ineligible for participation in OPERS. This fund will also be used to process payments on behalf of the affected employees to Social Security and may be used to distribute any refund due to the employees after the Social Security employee payments are made.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to process and correct pay retirement systems payments for Village employees in a prompt fashion, all to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




