

ORDINANCE 2012-31

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) GENERAL GOVERNMENT (SOLICITOR) SECTION (750) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has determined more monies are needed in the Personal Services section of the Solicitors budget than is currently appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has decided to move money from the Other Operations section of the budget to the Personal Services section of the budget in the General Government section.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village Of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


Section 1: The current appropriations in the General Government section are \$318,516 with \$121,846 in Personal Services and \$196,670 in Other Operations. The new distribution needs to be \$126,046 in Personal Services and \$192,470 in Other Operations. There is no change in the total appropriations.


Section 2: Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because the Fiscal Officer has determined the Personal Services section of the budget needs the additional funding for wages and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


