

ORDINANCE 2012-37

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$3,500 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a request from Ohio Public Works for an appraisal of the 5.199 acre parcel on the North Side of Bancroft Street identified as 6475 Bancroft Street, Hiram, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, said appraisal needs to be done in compliance with the Uniform Appraisal Standards for Federal Land Acquisitions; and

WHEREAS, the Village has secured a bid from Spalding/Emig Company in the amount of \$3,500 to perform said appraisal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$1,109,399.10 through Ordinance 2012-34. The General Fund needs to be increased by \$3,500 making the new total \$1,112,899.10.


SECTION 2: The new total for the General Government will be: Personal Services \$126,046 and Other Operations \$195,970. The total appropriations for the General Government will be \$322,016. This is an increase of \$3,500 to pay for the appraisal on the old elementary school property.



SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


