

ORDINANCE 2012-40

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE KIDS AND COPS FISHING DAY FUND (2274) BY \$425.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the event has taken place and the total receipts are in; and

WHEREAS, the amount of the money received for this event was less than anticipated.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in this fund are \$1,000 and need to be reduced to \$575.00. This is the amount of the funds received.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor so the appropriations will reflect the actual amount of the receipts since the event is completed.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
