

ORDINANCE 2012-33

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) FIRE DEPARTMENT SECTION (120) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has determined more monies are needed in the Personal Services section of the Fire Department budget than is currently appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has requested an increase of \$2,000 in the appropriations of the Fire Department in the General Fund to cover wages.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village Of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


Section 1: The current appropriations in the Fire Department section are \$136,626 with \$58,000 in Personal Services and \$78,626 in Other Operations. The new distribution needs to be \$60,000 in Personal Services and \$78,626 in Other Operations. The new total appropriations of the General Fund will be \$1,109,339.10.


Section 2: Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because the Fire department needs the additional funding for wages and to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


