

## ORDINANCE 2015-02

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE No. 2003-33 and BY-LAWS OF THE HIRAM COMMUNITY BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION.

**WHEREAS**, the Hiram Community Beautification Commission was created by the Hiram Village Council in 1988 by Ordinance 88-28; and,

**WHEREAS**, the By-laws of the Hiram Beautification Commission are contained in Ordinances: 89-32, 91-14, 93-16A and 2003-33; and,

**WHEREAS**, it has come to the attention of the Hiram Village Council requested by THE HIRAM COMMUNITY BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION in its January 2015 meeting that substantial changes and amendments are needed, so that the said Commission can operate effectively and efficiently to carry out the September 1988 trust/endowment of Mr. Reign Hadsell.

**NOW THEREFORE** be it resolved by a majority of the Hiram Village Council that The Hiram Community Beautification Commission Ordinance and By Laws are hereby amended as follows and all past Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and have no effect.

#### SECTION 1:

##### **145.01 NAME.**

The name of this organization is the **HIRAM COMMUNITY BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION**, hereinafter referred to as "Commission".

##### **145.02 LOCATION.**

The **COMMISSION** shall be located in the Village of Hiram, Ohio.

##### **145.03 PURPOSE.**

The purpose of this Commission is to beautify the Village and its environs, specially the Village, College and Township and to carry out the gift of September 1988 trust/endowment of Mr. Reign Hadsell as determined by the **COMMISSION**.

##### **145.04 STRUCTURE.**

The Commission shall be under the jurisdiction of the Hiram Village Council and no expenses of the said gift of September 1988 trust/endowment of Mr. Reign Hadsell shall be expended except by the concurrence of Hiram Village Council. The Commission shall select a Chair and the Fiscal Officer of the Village or his/her designate is to act as Secretary. The Commission meets no fewer than three (3) times a year and can specify any needed procedures, by-laws and or rules.

##### **145.05 MEMBERSHIP.**

The membership of the Hiram Community Beautification Commission shall consist of the following: (1) one representative from the Hiram Village Council appointed by the Mayor; (2) one representative from Hiram Village who is an elector appointed by the Mayor with the concurrence of Council; (3) one representative from the Hiram Township Trustees; (4) one representative from Hiram Township, who is an elector; (5) one representative from Hiram College as appointed by its President; (6) one representative from Hiram Public Gardens; (7) the Mayor of Hiram Village who shall sit ex officio; and (8) the Village Administrator or his/her designate.

**145.06 QUORUM.**

A quorum for the Commission to conduct business shall consist of the attendance of three (3) or more members present at the meeting as set forth in Section 145.05 above.

**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
