

ORDINANCE 2015-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND (2021) OPERATING SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS PROGRAM CODE (620) BY \$2,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator, given the severity of our winter season, believes there may be an insufficient amount of road salt to properly treat the roads and protect the welfare of all individuals traveling through Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined that appropriations in the State Highway Fund will need to be increased in order to purchase road salt for the Village of Hiram for the remainder of the 2015 winter season; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has requested a total of \$2,000 be appropriated into Other Operations to the Operating Supplies and Materials line item 2021-620-420-0000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village Of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the State Highway Fund are \$980. The Village Administrator is requesting an additional \$2,000 be appropriated. The new total appropriations in the State Highway Fund will be \$2,980.


Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order to protect the health, safety and general welfare of the Village and because time is of the essence so the residents of the Village can benefit from the purchase of road salt for the state highways.
