

ORDINANCE 2015-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (4901) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief of the Village of Hiram has determined that the Police Department is in need of a reliable patrol vehicle which would help to protect the safety of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief presented this to the Finance Committee and has requested permission to use their Capital Improvement Funds for the purchase of a 2015 Ford Police Interceptor; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram at their last meeting has determined that money from the Capital Improvement Funds should be used for the purchase of this necessary police equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram has previously transferred money into the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) to be used for such a purchase.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) are \$34,500. An increase of \$27,000 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$61,500.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence so the residents of the Village can benefit from the purchase of a new patrol vehicle.


SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliances with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency March 10, 2015.


