

ORDINANCE 2015-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (4901) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department personnel have researched and negotiated for the purchase of a 2015 Ford Explorer Interceptor to replace their car #1; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department has requested permission to use their Capital Improvement Funds for the purchase of the 2015 Ford Explorer Interceptor and for equipment upgrades as authorized; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has determined that money from the Capital Improvement Fund should be used for the purchase of a new Fire Department vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously transferred money into the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) to be used for such a purchase.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Capital Improvement Fund (4901) are \$61,500. An increase of \$28,500 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$90,000.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence so the residents of the village can benefit from the purchase of this new fire vehicle.



Passed in Council as an emergency March 10, 2015.




