

ORDINANCE 2015-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND (2081) BY \$1,900.

WHEREAS, Chief Samec has received funds from court fines which have been receipted into the Drug Law Enforcement Fund; and

WHEREAS, Chief Samec desires to use some of these funds to cover small items needed for the purpose of the Drug Task Force Agent; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations in this fund will need to be increased to accommodate these purchases.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio a majority of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Drug Law Enforcement Fund (2081) are \$100.

SECTION 2: An additional \$1,900 has been requested making the new total appropriations in this fund \$2,000.


SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
