

ORDINANCE 2015-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$29,756.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator presented Council with a proposal from Ronyak Paving, Inc. to repave a portion of Bancroft Street from Peckham Street to the Great Northern Apartments; and

WHEREAS, said proposal will be accepted and approved by Council in Resolution 2015-09 in order to allow the repaving to be completed as soon as weather conditions and the schedule of Ronyak Paving, Inc. permits; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations will need to be increased in the General Fund in order to cover the cost of repaving this portion of Bancroft Street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$887,248.00. The appropriations in the General Fund will need to be increased by \$29,756.00 making the new total \$917,004.00.

SECTION 2: The new appropriations will be placed into appropriation code 1000-610-300-0006, Contractual Services (Street Dept.) for Construction and Reconstruction of Streets and Roadways.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor so that the necessary improvements to Bancroft Street will be done at the earliest possible opportunity for the benefit of the residents of the Village.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


