

ORDINANCE 2015-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$33,619.93

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Hiram informed the Finance Committee of unencumbered balances from 2014 in the Police Department, the Fire Department, the Street Department and the Administrative Department; and

WHEREAS, Council planned for future capital expenditures through Resolution 2009-08 which authorized one-half of the unencumbered balances to be transferred into the Capital Improvement Fund for future expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, a majority of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$917,004.00. The new appropriations will be \$950,623.93.

SECTION 2: The breakdown of the transfer out accounts are as follows: the Police Department transfer out line will be appropriated at \$2,996.13, the Fire Department transfer out line will be appropriated at \$667.52, the Street Department transfer out line will be appropriated at \$6,917.65 and the Administrative Department transfer out line will be appropriated at \$23,038.63. These amounts from the four departments are currently not appropriated. The new appropriations for these four departments will total \$33,619.93.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


