

**ORDINANCE 2015-23**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$3,226 AND AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE OF \$3,226 TO THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2275) BODY ARMOR GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief informed the Fiscal Officer of an award of \$3,226 for a Body Armor Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Body Armor Grant is a reimbursing grant so money will have to be advanced from the General Fund to the Body Armor Grant Fund (2275).

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$1,021,278.93. The appropriations need increased by \$3,226 in the other financing uses section, other operations. The new total appropriations in the General Fund will be \$1,024,504.93.

**Section 2:** The current appropriations in the Special Revenue Fund are ZERO. The appropriations need increased by \$3,226 in 2275-110-420-0004. The new total appropriations in the Special Revenue Fund will be \$3,226.


**Section 3:** This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Police Department to begin using the grant funds to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

**Section 4:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
