

ORDINANCE 2015-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, several Departments and Committees of the Village of Hiram have been successful in obtaining additional revenue funds through grants and donations; and

WHEREAS, these same Departments and Committees wish to utilize these funds as soon as possible for the betterment of the Village and its residents; and

WHEREAS, several funds will need to have their appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the funds needing amendments:
