

ORDINANCE 2015-27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$20,700 AND THE WATER (5101) & SEWER (5201) FUNDS EACH BY \$4,130 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram created a new position of Full-Time Assistant Village Administrator in order to hire, train and have that person in place upon the retirement of the longtime Village Administrator, Bob Wood, to allow for a smooth transition for the Village; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations account codes set up for this position for wages and benefits have not been appropriated and will be short to finish the year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund (1000) are \$1,085,086.93. The Personal Services section of the Street Department needs to be increased by \$17,620 from \$76,028 to \$93,648. The Other Operations section of the Street Department needs to be increased by \$3,080 from \$26,782 to \$29,862. The new total appropriations in the General Fund (1000) will be \$1,105,786.93.

Section 2: The current appropriations in the Water Fund (5101) are \$330,941.96. The Personal Services section of the Water Department needs to be increased by \$3,050 from \$89,521 to \$92,571. The Other Operations section of the Water Department needs to be increased by \$1,080 from \$241,420.96 to \$242,500.96. The new total appropriations in the Water Fund (5101) will be \$335,071.96.


Section 3: The current appropriations in the Sewer Fund (5201) are \$279,607.52. The Personal Services section of the Sewer Department needs to be increased by \$3,050 from \$89,696 to \$92,746. The Other Operations section of the Sewer Department needs to be increased by \$1,080 from \$189,911.52 to \$190,991.52. The new total appropriations in the Sewer Fund (5201) will be \$283,737.52.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to provide for the health and safety of the residents of Hiram Village.


