

ORDINANCE 2015-34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2902) HIRAM COMMUNITY TRUST GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Hiram Village Recreation & Park Board has applied for and was successful in receiving a \$4,875 grant from the Hiram Community Trust to help with development of the **Hiram Village Park & Prairie Loop** project on the Hiram School Park property; and

WHEREAS, monies will need to be appropriated to cover the grant funds.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** The current appropriations in the Hiram Community Trust Fund are \$0. The appropriations will need to be increased to \$4,875. The new total appropriations in the Hiram Community Trust Fund will be \$4,875.00.


**Section 2:** This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, the particular emergency being the grant application has already been submitted and the Hiram Village Recreation & Park Board has been awarded the grant.

**Section 3:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


