

ORDINANCE 2015-36

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE PORTAGE COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR DEFENSE OF INDIGENT PERSONS CHARGED WITH CRIMINAL OFFENSES UNDER THE VILLAGE ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio a majority of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are authorized on behalf of the Village to execute a contract with the Portage County Public Defender Commission for the representation of indigent persons charged under Hiram Village ordinances for and during the calendar year 2016 substantially in conformance with the terms and conditions as the contract for 2015, and for the compensation of eighty dollars (\$80.00) per offense charged. The approved Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
