

ORDINANCE 2022-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL TRAINING FUND (2272) BY \$1,848.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Chief Gregory has received payment in the amount of \$1,848.00, from the Ohio Attorney General's Office for Continued Professional Training (CPT); and

WHEREAS, Chief Gregory would like to utilize the funds received to benefit the Hiram Police Departments training program; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations in the special revenue fund will need to be increased to accommodate the grant funds received.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL TRAINING Fund (2272) are \$1,500.00. An increase of \$813.94 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$ 2,313.94.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence so the residents of the Village can benefit from the training of their police officers.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliances with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
