

ORDINANCE 2022-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Departments within the Village of Hiram have been successful in their efforts to apply for and be awarded grant funds to benefit the Village by purchasing equipment and making improvements to Village properties; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has requested additional funds to make improvements to the Rosser Municipal building fire department bay doors, rear parking lot area and improvements to the wastewater treatment plant drive; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer is requesting to amend appropriations in Water Operating 5101 to cover the first two loan payments for the Replacement Water Meters and AMR System project which is near completion and which OWDA has already notified the Village of the first payment coming due in July; and

WHEREAS, to meet these obligations several funds will need to have their appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated funds:
