

ORDINANCE 2022-10

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Police Chief received a donation for the upcoming Kids & Cops Fishing Day event and would like to have the appropriations amended in Fund 2274 to use those funds toward the purchase of t-shirts and fishing poles; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has lost medical coverage that was provided to him through his spouse's employer and due to this qualifying event, has been added to the Village's medical plan; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief was successful in securing additional police coverage to Hiram Township from 64 hours to 100 hours per month and must now have his appropriations amended to cover the additional hours, OPERS and Medicare in his Personal Services & Other line items for Hiram Township Part-time; and

WHEREAS, the Council approved the purchase of a 2022 Kubota Track Loader with attachments not to exceed \$95,000, the Mayor and Fiscal Officer have executed a Certificate of Deposit to be used as cash collateral for a bank loan which will be paid directly to the Village of Hiram in order to pay the vendor for the equipment, which now necessitates amending revenue and appropriations for the 2012 Street Infrastructure Fund to account for the loan funds and payment to Middlefield Farm & Garden; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is requesting to amend appropriations in Water Operating 5101 to cover emergency service on Well Pump #1; and

WHEREAS, to meet these obligations several funds will need to have their appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated funds:

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
