

ORDINANCE 2022-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT REVENUE AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE HIRAM ENERGY SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (ESID) FUND 9904 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Portage County Auditor has the authority to administer the special assessment obligation of Mantaline Corporation for their inclusion in the Hiram Energy Special Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, the Portage County Auditor collects the special assessment bi-annually and assesses a fee or service charge for the collection of the assessment and forwards those funds to the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer receipts the funds and fees into the UAN system and then forwards the assessment payment to NOPEC; and

WHEREAS, to meet this obligation Fund 9904 will need to have its revenue & appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated fund:

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order to advance the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Hiram, and further to allow the Village of Hiram to comply with law in accepting the fee or service charge from the Portage County Auditor and to account for the financial obligations of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
