

ORDINANCE 2022-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council passed legislation at their August 30, 2022 special meeting to retire the K-9 Officer Guapo and to expend all funds remaining in the K-9 fund for the care of Guapo; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief would like to have the permanent appropriations amended to utilize those funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator presented the Finance & Safety Commission with quotes to perform necessary emergency roof repairs to various Village buildings and the Commission recommended by motion to replace roofs on the Hiram Salon, Light Plant & WWTP buildings which now requires amending the appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer is requesting to amend appropriations in Water Operating 5101 and Sewer Operating 5201 to cover the recommendation by motion from the Finance & Safety Commission to move a portion of the Fiscal Officer's salary and Asst. Fiscal Officer's salary to more accurately reflect the work they perform for these two departments; and

WHEREAS, to meet these obligations several funds will need to have their appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated funds:

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the necessary departments of the Village of Hiram to continue to function and pay their obligations to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
