ORDINANCE 2022-14

AN ORDINANCE SETTING BASE COMPENSATION RANGES FOR EMPLOYMENT POSITIONS AT THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, REPEALING ORDINANCE 2020-02 AND OTHER INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has determined to establish compensation ranges for the use of Department Heads and other officials of the Village when performing annual employee evaluations and making recommendations to the Village Council as to the amount of appropriate annual raises for Village employees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, OHIO, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring, that:

- -Acting Lieutenant \$.50/Hour

In the event the above base rates will result in payment to any employee in an amount which is less than the Federal or State minimum wage for any pay period (defined as a set or regular period not less than 7 days nor more than 28 days or as otherwise defined by the Fair Labor Standards Act 29 U.S.C.A. Sections 201 et seq.) then, in that event, that employee shall be paid the Federal or State minimum wage for the actual hours worked.

SECTION 2: Ordinance 2020-02 and other ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
