

ORDINANCE 2022-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$55,748.14 AND AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER BY THE FISCAL OFFICER OF \$55,748.14 TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATING FUND (2914) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the contract entered into with Hiram Township for EMS and Fire Services, Ordinance 2009-09 Exhibit "A" requires the Village to follow the guidelines set forth within the contract with regards to percentages of contribution by both parties; and

WHEREAS, to comply with the Hiram Township contract for EMS and Fire Services the following transfer needs to be made.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with two thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: According to the contract, the Village of Hiram will contribute two-thirds (2/3) of the Township's contribution for the Fire Budget, which is funded out of a transfer from the General Fund to the Fire Department Operations fund.

SECTION 2: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$871,173.20. The appropriations need increased by \$55,748.14 in 1000-910-910-0005, General Fund (1000), transfers (910), transfers out (910), Fire Dept. (0005) so that a transfer of \$55,748.14 can be made to the Fire Department Operations Fund 2914-931-0005. The new total appropriations in the General Fund will be \$926,921.34.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the fire department to use the funds transferred for general operations to provide for the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
