

ORDINANCE 2022-16

AN ORDINANCE TO PUT IN PLACE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS AT THE FUND LEVEL FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, DURING THE FIRST QUARTER OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2023.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING, THAT TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES OF SAID VILLAGE OF HIRAM DURING THE FIRST QUARTER OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2023, THE FOLLOWING SUMS ARE HEREBY SET ASIDE AND APPROPRIATED AT THE FUND LEVEL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 6: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certification and vouchers therefore, approved and authorized by the Board or Officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make expenditures; provided that no warrant shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by the authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 7: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Section 8: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor for the reason that it is necessary to have 2023 temporary appropriations ready to be put in place before the end of 2022. The appropriations are necessary to keep the services to the citizens of the Village of Hiram operating smoothly.
