

ORDINANCE 2022-20

**AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 351.17 OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM
CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO ESTABLISH PARKING PERMIT PROVISIONS.**

WHEREAS, the Village Council has decided that it is appropriate to establish paid parking throughout the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the required changes the Hiram Village Codified Ordinances must be revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, a majority or more of the members thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The provisions set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" are hereby enacted as section 351.17 of the Village of Hiram Codified Ordinances.



EXHIBIT A

351.17 PAID PARKING

(a) Paid parking zones. The establishment, placement, and configuration of paid parking zones on Village streets shall be on all street parking, excluding where posted with signage with time limits, Village roads and state highways, as directed by the Village administration.

(b) Prohibited Parking. No person shall park a vehicle in any area on a Village street that is designated as a paid parking zone without having a parking permit or having made the required payment for the time in which the vehicle is parked in the paid parking zone.

(c) Enforcement Hours. Payment of parking within paid parking zones shall only be permitted twenty-one (21) hours per day, from 5am to 2 am, seven (7) days per week, unless otherwise indicated by the Village administration. No parking on public streets shall be permitted from 2 am to 5 am.

(d) Parking Permits. Parking permits, for yearly parking on the street, can be obtained at the Village Hall for the current fee established by the Village. The permit must be displayed in the front window of the vehicle while parked in a paid parking zone.

(e) Separate Offence. A separate offense shall be deemed committed if the vehicle remains in violation of subsection (b) after a period of twenty-four (24) hours after the initial citation is issued.

(f) Village, Public Utility, and Emergency Vehicles. Whenever it is necessary for Village, Public Utility, or Emergency Vehicles to park in paid parking zones in order to conduct service calls or other public business, they may be permitted to do so at no cost and without a permit.
