

ORDINANCE 2024-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2024-05 TO CORRECT LANGUAGE IN THE EXHIBIT "A" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a discrepancy was discovered between the language in Exhibit "A" of Ordinance 2023-23, passed on November 14, 2023, and Exhibit "A" of Ordinance 2024-05, passed on March 12, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2024-05 to correct the discrepancies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio a majority or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The existing Exhibit "A" of Ordinance 2024-05 passed on March 12, 2024 is hereby repealed.


Section 2: Exhibit "A" of Ordinance 2024-05, amending Village of Hiram Codified Ordinances Section 319.06(a) is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A".


Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village and its residents, the emergency being the need to pass this Ordinance to permit the corrected version of Codified Ordinance Section 319.06(a) to accurately reflect the provisions of the Ordinance. Therefore, provided it receives two-thirds (2/3) of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency on May 14, 2024.

Exhibit "A"

319.06 CIVIL PENALTIES.

(a) Unless the driver of a motor vehicle received a citation from a police officer at the time of the violation, or unless an exception or defense to liability set forth in Section 319.05 applies, the owner or responsible party for the motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty of the motor vehicle as recorded by a law enforcement officer using an Officer-Operated Traffic Law Enforcement Device while being operated in violation of this Chapter.

(b) The civil penalty under this chapter shall be the following:

(1)

A. Miles Per Hour Over Speed Limit	Amount of Penalty
1-19	\$150
20-29	\$200
30 or more	\$250
B. Within a school zone	
1-9	\$200
10-29	\$250
30 or more	\$300
