

ORDINANCE 2024-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief for the Village of Hiram made application and was awarded a grant from the Hiram Community Trust for \$1,100.00 to use toward any of the Police programs that involve community outreach and the Police Chief has determined to divide this grant between the Bike Rodeo, Fishing Day and Halloween; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram has made a change to their legal representation in that legal counsel will be provided by the firm of Reitz, Paul & Shorr per contract rather than a Village Solicitor as a contract employee and now the appropriations in the personal services and other payroll deduction line items must be reallocated to a new line item for legal counsel; and

WHEREAS, to meet these obligations several funds will need to have their appropriations increased or reallocated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the GENERAL Fund (1000) are \$816,822.76. An increase of \$400.00 in new appropriations for 1000-110-420-0301 (HPD Bike Rodeo) is hereby approved and an increase of \$300.00 in new appropriations for 1000-110-420-0304 (HPD Halloween) is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$817,522.76.


SECTION 2: The current appropriations in the KIDS AND COPS FISHING DAY Fund (2274) are \$500.00. An increase of \$400.00 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount of \$900.00.

SECTION 3: The current appropriations in the GENERAL Fund 1000-750-141-0000 (Salary-Legal Counsel) of \$13,944.00 and 1000-750-211-0000 (OPERS) of \$2,014.54 and 1000-750-213-0000 (Medicare) of \$262.08 will be reallocated to the GENERAL Fund 1000-725-349-0400 (Legal Representation) with no change in the total permanent appropriations for the General Fund.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the necessary departments of the Village of Hiram to continue to function and pay their obligations to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency on July 9, 2024.
