

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-29

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A UTILITY EASEMENT TO OHIO EDISON COMPANY FOR ACCESS TO A SUBSTATION WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram has received requests from Ohio Edison Company, a public utility, for an easement on Wakefield Road a dedicated public street within the Village of Hiram to its substation on parcel # 22-023-10-00-093-000; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has considered the request and has determined that it is in the public interest to grant to Ohio Edison a utility easement, so as to permit Ohio Edison to maintain and upgrade the electric infrastructure within the Village.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, State of Ohio a majority or more of the members thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator is authorized to execute the utility easement in substantial conformity with that set forth as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein and by reference.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: The Village Council finds that this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage in order to promote the health, safety and general welfare of the Village and for the further reason to allow for the proper maintenance of the property.
