

RESOLUTION 2011-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A TWO-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH HIRAM COLLEGE FOR THE HIRAM FIRE DEPARTMENT AND HIRAM VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO HIRAM COLLEGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Hiram Fire Department and the Hiram Village Police Department have provided fire and emergency service as well as police services to Hiram College in the past and there is a request from Hiram College to continue these services in the years 2011 & 2012; and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been prepared that is acceptable to the Village of Hiram and Hiram College for the years 2011 & 2012.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Hiram College for fire and emergency services provided by Hiram Fire Department, said agreement to be substantially in conformance with the terms and conditions as are found in exhibit "A" attached hereto and made part hereof.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Hiram College for police services provided by Hiram Police Department, said agreement to be substantially in conformance with the terms and conditions as are found in exhibit "A" attached hereto and made part hereof.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage, to enable the village to continue the usual daily services for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and welfare within the whole of the village and because the Village is presently providing the protections set forth in the agreement.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




