

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE WITHIN HIRAM VILLAGE, PORTAGE COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has determined that the health, safety and welfare of the community will be advanced by using one (1) residential solid waste collection service and to accomplish that end has enacted Chapter 927 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has caused a bid specifications for solid waste collection service to be generated; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has determined that the matter of who should be the single provider of solid waste collection within the Village should be advertised for bid forthwith.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hiram Village Council, two thirds or more its members concurring that:


SECTION 1: Advertisement for solid waste collection service within the Village of Hiram in substantial conformity with the bid specifications attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "A" is hereby authorized.


SECTION 2: That the Village administration is authorized to determine the actual date of the publication of the request for bids and the date for opening the bids received.


SECTION 3: That this Resolution be declared an emergency measure becoming immediately effective upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order to advance the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the citizens of the Village and for the further reason that the competitive bidding can then take place in conjunction with bidding for the same services by Hiram Township and economies of scale can be realized by the combined bid package.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public sale in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


